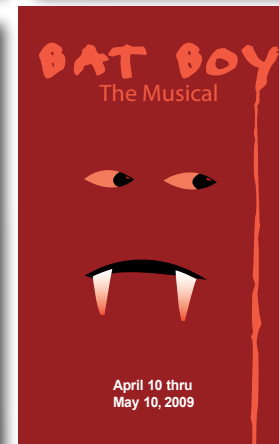
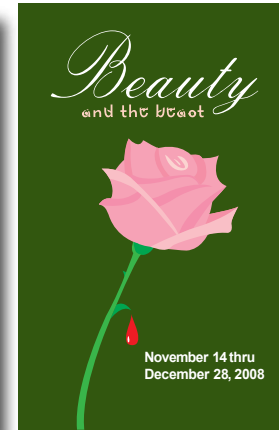
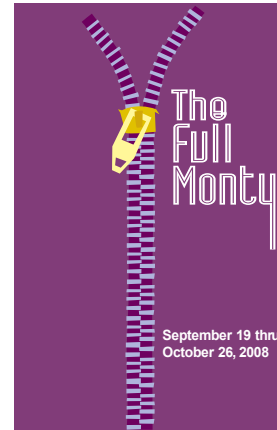

What We Do

The mission of the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center is to enrich the cultural, social, and educational life of the community through professionally produced live theatre, concerts, and other cultural experiences and special programming for children.

Attendance for all 157 performances this season topped 31,200, with nearly 2,500 attending Town Hall Arts Center for the first time this season. Preview performances of each main stage musical were attended by over 600 individuals served by ArtReach, Above and Beyond, Star Reach, and Colorado School for the Blind, who would otherwise not be able to attend.

Town Hall Children's Programming

Attendance at children's theatre performances during 08-09 totaled 2,171 who attended 9 performances of *The Further Adventures of Maide Marian* in the fall and 10 performances of *Destination Dinosaurs* in the spring. Approximately 650 students in need were able to see our children's theatre productions in 08-09 free of charge thanks to our foundation and governmental grants.

We also held multiple sessions of our Actors' Playground -- children's theatre workshop classes for ages 6 – 15 (4 sessions Summer 2008, 3 sessions Fall 2008, 4 sessions Winter/Spring 2009).

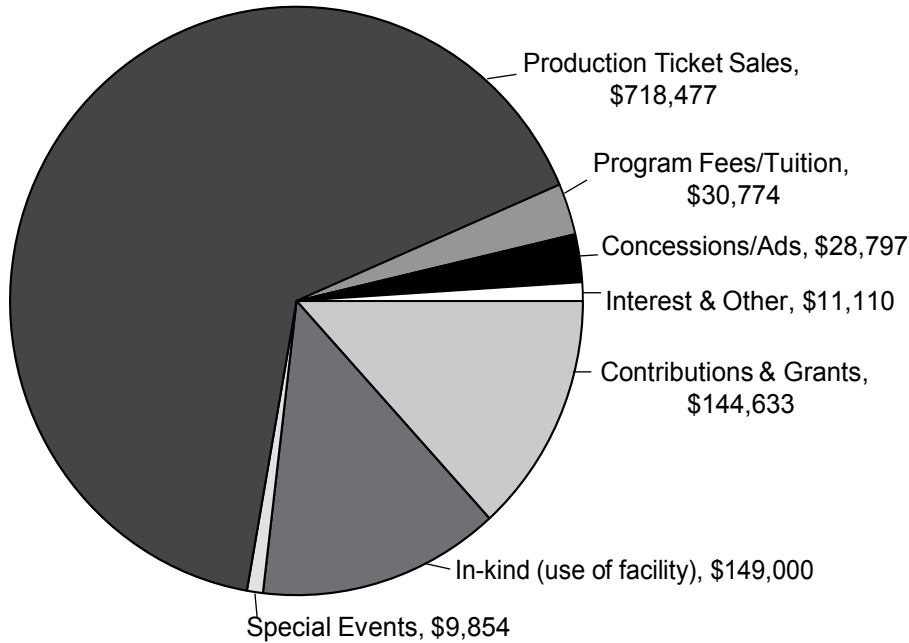

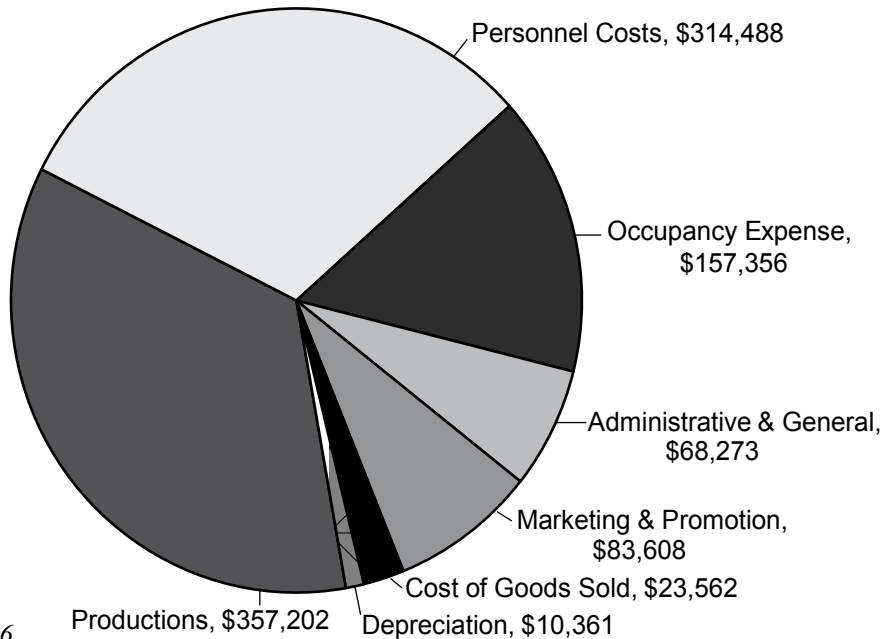
